

Square & Rectangular Garden Kit

Four-sided planter assembled from two side frames

INCLUDED

- 4 corner brackets
- 24 cedar planks cut to the required length
- 100 #8 x 3/4 in. screws (96 required)

YOU WILL NEED

- Drill with Phillips bit or screwdriver
- Measuring tape and square

SAFETY

Wear work gloves and safety glasses. Sheet metal edges may be sharp and cedar can splinter. Use hearing and face protection when cutting lumber.

Build two side frames

- Choose a level location. For sides over 6 ft, add centre support brackets to reduce bowing.
- If using 4 x 4 corner posts, attach them first. The cedar will then seat flush in the corner brackets.
- Otherwise, mark 1.5 in. from each plank end. The rounded corner of each bracket identifies the top.
- Using two corner brackets, install six planks from top to bottom. Align each flange with the mark and fasten through the flange holes.
- Repeat with the remaining two corner brackets to make the second side frame.

Join the frames

- Stand both completed side frames upright.
- Connect them with the remaining cedar planks, working from top to bottom. Tip the structure carefully onto a side if needed for drilling access.

Fill and plant

- Fill with soil. A centre filler or drainage material may reduce soil volume; keep planting soil around the perimeter.
- Use landscape fabric beneath the planter if needed, and arrange crops according to sun exposure and mature growth habit.
